






Juneteenth National Independence Day celebrates the emancipation of the last enslaved African Americans when on June 19, 1865 Gen. Gordon Granger arrived in Galveston, Texas, to deliver General Order No. 3, officially ending slavery in the state.

Now therefore let it be resolved, the East Georgia Housing Authority Partners (EGHAP), serving the consortia of housing authorities which includes the Housing Authority of the City of Thomson, Housing Authority of the City of Warrenton, Housing Authority of the City of Harlem, and Housing Authority of the City of Crawfordville, have so moved to adopt Juneteenth (June 19<sup>th</sup>), as a designated paid Holiday for eligible EGHAP Personnel.
