



LIVE-IN AIDE ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

The definition of a Live-In-Aide is as follows:

24 CFR 5.402

“Live-in Aide” means a person who resides with one or more elderly persons, or near-elderly persons, or persons with disabilities, and who:

- (1) Is determined to be essential to the care and well -being of the person;***
- (2) Is not obligated for the support of the persons; and***
- (3) Would not be living in the unit except to provide the necessary supportive service***

By signing this acknowledgement, you are saying you understand that we will screen you as if you were an applicant, your income will not be included in the household rent calculation; and if the residency of the person you are giving supports to were to change, or in case of their death, you have no rights in the household to be added to the dwelling lease.

Although you will not be on the dwelling lease as a household member, you are expected to conduct yourself in a manner that will not disturb the right of a peaceful enjoyment of the person of whom you are offering supportive services, nor the other tenants who live in the community. Should you cause a disturbance, or for any other good cause, you will be asked to leave and that could result in you being barred from the property.
